Welcome To Today's Game

Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this South West Regional Women's Football League fixture against Bideford AFC Women, who visit the Gerard Buxton Ground for the second time. It is just short of a month since the last league game against Bishops Lydeard which the Ladies won comfortably 9-1. The match report from that game is included in today's programme. Recent fixtures have had to be postponed due to County Cup fixtures, the Women's FA Cup and bad weather. If you are reading this the good news is that today's game is on.

A special warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Bideford who have made the long journey to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground today from Devon. We hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

This will be the fourth time the two sides have met in the Premier Division of the South West Regional Women's Football League and Royal Wootton Bassett Town currently have a 100% winning record in these league fixtures. In Season 2019-20 we won a close game 2-1 here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground thanks to goals from Hayley Huckin and Lauren Kayll. The two sides then met again in Devon just seven days later and Bassett this time secured a more comfortable win, Hayley and Lauren again scoring in a 3-0 win, the other goal coming courtesy of an own goal. Last season the sides met just the once before Covid-19 once again brought a premature end to the season, two goals from Grace Eagles and one apiece from Amber Egerton and Shannon King in a 4-1 win. A brief match report from that game is also included in today's programme.

Like ourselves Bideford have yet to complete a season in the Premier Division but both sides will be hoping that this current season will go the full duration. Whilst Bideford have had two decent partial seasons in the Premier Division they have not made a good start to the current season. So far they have lost all five of their opening league games and made early exits from both the FA Cup and the Devon County Cup. They have also suffered a six points deduction for postponed games that leaves them at the bottom of the early league table. Whilst all games have been lost their best performance came in their last outing against Middlezoy, going down 3-1 in the end and we will need to make sure we are at our best to ensure we pick up the three points here this afternoon.

After receiving a walkover in the First Round of the Wiltshire County Cup, with Swindon Supermarine being unable to raise a side, the Ladies have been drawn away to Warminster Town in the Quarter Final. With five of the scheduled seven First Round fixtures ending in walkovers, the First Round was a bit of a farce. The two games that did get played resulted in big wins for Swindon Town (15-0 away at Marlborough Town) and FC Chippenham (12-2 at home to FC Calne). It was important to avoid Swindon Town in the Quarter Final draw but Warminster will be a tough game. They currently sit in third place in the Eastern Division of the South West Regional Women's Football League with two wins from their opening three games. The County Cup match is scheduled for Sunday 21st November.

Enjoy the game and hopefully another win for the Ladies.

We will approach today's game in a positive manner, play good football, and look for another 3 points.

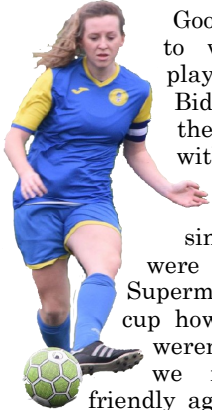

Opponents In Focus

Bideford A.F.C. is an English non-league football club from Bideford, Devon whose senior men's side plays in the Evo-Stik Southern League Division One South & West. The club was first formed in the late 1890's and was then called "Bideford Town". They were nicknamed "The Robins" due to their red shirts and remain so to this day. Since the first decade of the twentieth century, the club has predominantly played at the Sports Ground, Kingsley Road in Bideford. Until entering hibernation for the duration of World War Two it was a highly successful club, albeit one that played the majority of it's football in North Devon.

Following it's reformation in the 1947/48 season, the club was reborn as "Bideford Association Football Club" and entered the Exeter and East Devon League. Bideford were runners up in the 1948/49 season, and applied to join then the Western League. Bideford won Division Three without losing a game and two seasons later they won the second division and promotion to Division One. At this time the club did not have a club house but there was a Nissen Hut just inside the main gate and a wooden grandstand, which was replaced with the present one after the Bradford City fire disaster.

In 1964/65 Bideford reached the first round proper of the FA Cup, and drew away at Colchester United 3-3 and lost home in the replay 1-2, at which BBC cameras were present. Bideford won the Western League three times before joining the Southern League in 1972. The club spent three seasons in the Southern league before the extra expense involved and increased travelling took its toll, forcing them to drop down back to the Western League. During their time in the Southern League, the club set an all-time FA Cup record when in 1974-75 they played thirteen FA Cup games in a single season. Two more Western League titles followed in the early 1980s before a financial crisis hit the club. A re-formation took place in 1987 leading to the current set up, a company limited by guarantee under the revised company name Bideford AFC (1987) Ltd.

The club won four more Western League titles and also reached the FA Vase semi-finals where they lost to Winchester City. Despite winning the Western League four times under Manager Sean Joyce between 2000 to 2006, the club elected not to apply for promotion to the

Southern League due to the amount of travelling and expense that would be involved in playing teams which, almost without exception, would be over 100 miles away. However after winning the Western League again for the 10th time in the 2009/10 season and winning the Devon St Luke's Bowl where they beat Exeter City 2-1 in the final, Bideford AFC accepted promotion to the Southern League in May 2010 joining Division One South & West. In only their second season in Division One (S&W) Bideford were crowned Champions by an impressive eleven point margin and gained promotion for the first time in the club's history to the Southern League Premier Division. 2013/14 saw Bideford finish in their highest ever league position of 8th in the Premier Division but after four years at that level they were relegated for the first time in their history back to Division One in 2015/16.

The Ladies side at Bideford have been running for a number of years now. The earliest statistical information we have been able to trace is from Season 2011/12 when they were playing in Division 1 of the Devon Women's League. Season 2012/13 saw them promoted to the Premier Division after they had finished runners-up behind Ilfracombe. They were to spend four seasons in the Premier Division and in the final season of that four they won the league finishing a point ahead of Plymouth Argyle Res and were promoted to the South West Regional Women's League Western Division.

In their first season at the higher level they finished in a respectable fifth place. They improved on that in Season 2018-19 when they finished in third spot to gain promotion to the Premier Division.

Although Season 2019-20 was struck from the record books due to Covid-19, at the time the season was brought to a premature end Bideford had played all but three of their league fixtures and sat in a respectable sixth place in their first season at the higher level.

When Season 2020-21 was also ended early Bideford had won three out of the five league games played and sat in second place in the table. Unfortunately that momentum has not been carried forward into this season and they currently sit bottom of the table having lost all five league games to date and having six points deducted for postponed fixtures.

Grace Eagles continued her rich vein of goalscoring form as she scored twice and fired Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies to a convincing 4-1 home victory against Bideford in the team's first win of the 2020-21 season.

Building on their positive result away against Bishops Lydeard last week, Bassett's triumph was a fully deserved one, the side's attitude and effort being fantastic throughout a complete performance.

Eagles had found the net twice last week, helping her side record their opening point of the campaign, and got Bassett going again with a composed right foot finish that found the bottom corner following a great ball in from Hayley Huckin.

Bassett's second arrived as a result of the team's pressing proving too much for Bideford to handle. A turnover in possession was forced and the ball fell to Shannon King, who comfortably finished when one-on-one with the visitors' 'keeper.

Club stalwart Amber Egerton grabbed Bassett's third, rising highest in the box to head home from a Laura Jefferies corner.

Eagles then completed the scoring for the hosts as her shot from the edge of the area caught a deflection en-route to finding the back of the net.

There was ultimately to be no clean sheet as Rosie Kirk was unfortunate to turn the ball into her own net.

But a 4-1 victory was convincing enough and a due reward for an excellent display.
