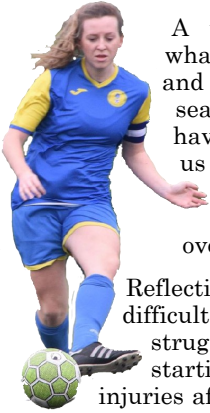

AFC St Austell

Opponents History

St Austell AFC were founded in 1890 and played at Rocky Park before moving to its current location at Poltair Park in the early part of the century. The club played in the Plymouth & District League and the Cornwall Senior League before joining the South Western League as founder members in 1951. St Austell became one of the few clubs to be ever present throughout the League's existence, and their 1-0 victory at Penzance in May 2007 was the final game in the South Western League. The Lillywhites won the league on only one occasion, winning in 1969, but were runners-up in 1963/64, 1965/66, 1971/72 and 1972/73. They also won the League Cup in 1988 and were beaten finalists in 1991.

The newly renamed AFC St Austell joined the South West Peninsula League for the 2007/08 season and had a difficult first season in Division 1 West. The following season saw a change of manager and marked improvement in results, ending the season in 3rd place in Division 1 West and winning the Senior Cup. The 2009/10 season saw St Austell finish as runners-up to Perranporth, winning promotion to the Premier Division. 2010/11 saw the Lillywhites finish in 10th place in the Premier Division and reach the Senior Cup Final.

The club has worked hard over the years in improving the facilities at Poltair Park and floodlights became a reality during the 2011/12 season, with the first game under lights being the home game against Buckland Athletic in front of a crowd of 556. Poltair Park also hosted a FA Youth Cup match between Cornwall and Huntingdonshire, the Cornwall Charity Cup semi-final between Penryn and Newquay and the Charity Cup Final itself. The 2012/13 season not only saw St Austell enter the FA Vase for the first time since 1996/97, losing 3-2 at home to Bemerton Heath Harlequins of the Wessex League in

Round 2, after home victories against Ashton & Backwell Utd of the Somerset County League in the Preliminary Round and fellow Peninsula Premier League Premier Division side Bovey Tracey in Round 1. The Lillywhites finished the season in fourth place and also hosted the Throgmorton Cup Semi-Final between Bodmin Town and Helston Athletic.

In 2013/14 St Austell finished in ninth place in the Premier Division but lifted the Cornwall Senior Cup, beating Bodmin Town on penalties at Wadebridge Town FC. The Lillywhites reached the Throgmorton Cup Final, losing 2-0 to Plymouth Parkway at the Devon FA headquarters in Newton Abbot.

The 2014/15 season was arguably the most successful in the club's history, winning the South West Peninsula League Premier Division with three games to spare and achieving a run of 24 consecutive victories in all competitions and retaining the Cornwall Senior Cup after a 3-0 victory against Godolphin Atlantic at Liskeard Athletic FC. The Lillywhites also reached the Semi-Final of the FA Vase, losing 2-1 on aggregate to Glossop North End, facing higher league opposition in every round of the competition from Round 2 onwards.

AFC St Austell established a Ladies side in Season 2019-20 in the Cornwall County League and were top of the table at the time the season was brought to a premature end by Covid-19. That performance earned them promotion to the South West Regional Women's Football League and Season 2020-21 saw them in the Western Division. Once again they were top of the table at the time Covid-19 once again brought the season to an early end. Once again this was enough to earn them promotion to the Premier Division. They have adapted well to life at the higher level and at the time of writing these notes are one of two sides unbeaten in the league.

Last Meeting

AFC St Austell 5 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 4

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies were once again involved a high-scoring thriller as they made the long trip to Cornwall to take on AFC St Austell. But, despite taking a 4-1 lead, Bassett returned to Wiltshire empty-handed as a stunning comeback saw the hosts claim a 5-4 victory.

The result extends a difficult league run for Bassett which has seen them win once in their last six fixtures - a stretch of form that has all but dashed hopes of a top three finish in the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division.

Those hopes had initially been reignited after an excellent first half display saw Bassett go into half time against St Austell - unbeaten going into the fixture - with a seemingly commanding 3-1 lead.

It took Libby Davies less than ten minutes to put her side in front as she latched onto

Maddy Elliott's through ball and coolly finished.

While Charlotte Whitmore equalised on the half hour mark, Holly Baker (pictured below) restored Bassett's lead as she headed in from Emma Sykes' inswinging corner. Sykes then added a second assist within a matter of minutes as Bassett extended their advantage. The hosts had just hit the bar and Bassett broke with the midfielder's pass splitting the home defence, and Davies was on hand to score.

And Bassett then moved into a three goal lead early in the second half as youngster Poppy Wannell raced onto a Davies through ball before producing a fine lob to make it 4-1.

Bassett's lead was a seemingly unassailable one. But four goals in the final thirty minutes stunned Bassett.

Whitmore twice found the net to complete her hat trick and reduced St Austell's deficit to just a goal. Francesca Thornton then headed home from a corner to equalise. Finally, with 92 minutes on the clock Chevonne Johanning found the bottom corner to complete the turnaround and deal Bassett a crushing blow.


