

Good afternoon everyone and welcome once again to Rylands Way for a Federated Homes Division 1 League Cup Fixture first round.

Last season in this competition we fell at the first hurdle when we were beaten by Cheltenham Town Reserves, so with a home draw this year in round 1 and the way the team are playing at the moment, we will hopefully progress to the 2nd round.

Since our last home game against a very well organised Milton United when we lost 0-1, Bassett have been going well. Following the Milton defeat, we have travelled to Viking Sports and won 3-0 with goals from Steve Ackrill, Warwick Burnett and a penalty from Tony Hoare and last week saw us away from home again at Easington when a spectacular headed goal from Neil Timbrell secured the points for us, so today the team should be full of confidence and hopefully dispose of Clanfield at the first time of asking.

Since being elected into the Federated Homes league, Bassett have not lost to Clanfield. In April last year we managed a 1-1 draw at their ground and then in October when they visited Rylands Was we convincingly beat them 6-2, so the odds of a victory today appear to be in our favour, having said that, Clanfield are emerging as the draw specialists, having drawn 4 of their 6 games so far, although the odds are in our favour, it could be a very tight game.

The Reserves continue to have mixed fortunes in Division 2 of Wilts County league. Defeats at the hands of Sandford in the Hardings Cup (formerly Ghia) and Stratton Red Eagles last week in the league with a home draw against Biddestone sandwiched in between is all that they have to show for their efforts over the past 3 weeks, but the team performances have been reasonably good and I am sure it is only a matter of time before we see them putting some good results together.

On a brighter note, the U12 team continue to do very well indeed. Last Saturday they travelled to Brinkworth to win 3-2 to take them into the semi-final of their league cup, and in so doing increased the goal tally to 53 in the 7 games played so far. If the boys maintain this type of momentum, they are in for a very successful season.

Well space eludes me again. Thanks for your support and lets hope we see a good entertaining competitive game today with a win for Bassett to take us into the next round of the Cup - talking of cup competitions, next week sees us in Cup action again when Oldacre visit in the Wilts Senior Cup KO 2.30pm, Oldacre are at present fielding one or two former Bassett players which should make the game interesting if nothing else.

"DID YOU KNOW" (A delve into the history books*)

- The Football league goal scoring record for a goalkeeper was set up in season 1923-24 by A Birch of Chesterfield. He played in every one of Chesterfield's Division III(N) matches that season and scored five goals, all from penalties.
- In season 1930-31, F Roberts, Glentoran centre forward, netted a total of 96 goals, in all competitions entered by his Club.
- 3. On 30 Jan 1960, G Baker scored 10 goals for St Mirren against Glasgow University, in the 1st round of Scottish Cup, but that didn't beat the 13 goals scored by J Petrie for Arbroath against Bon Accord on 5 Sep 1885.
- 4. Preston North End scored 6 goals in 7 minutes against Hyde in the FA Cup on 15 Oct 1887 - they eventually won 26-0. Every player scored except the goalkeeper.
- 5. One of the longest runs without a win in the Football league, was made by Crew Alexandria during 1956-57. After beating Scunthorpe United 2-1 on 19 Sep 1956, they did not win again until 13 Apr 1957 when they defeated Bradford City 1-0 - a run of 30 games in Division III(N) without a victory.
- The first ever game by floodlight took place at Bramall Lane, Sheffield on 14 Oct 1878.


