

Thanks for your support today, and to the few that braved the elements last week an even bigger thank you, I only hope that the conditions this week are more conducive to good soccer, but even more important I hope we see a better performance from Bassett.

FROM THE RECORDS**

(**The encyclopaedia of Association Football)
(compiled by Maurice Golesworthy)

I have delved yet again into the record book and have come up with some more interesting facts:

- 1. The youngest player ever to appear in Division 1 of the Football League is D FORSTER who kept goal for Sunderland against Leicester City on 22 August 1964 at the age of 15 yrs and 185 days.
- 2. The oldest player ever to appear in the Football League is N McBAIN, who, at the age of 52 years 4 months played in goal for New Brighton against Hartlepools United on 15 March 1947.
- 3. 199,850 people watched the international match between Brazil and Uruguay in the World Cup Final played at Rio de Janeiro on 16 July 1950.
- 4. Throughout the history of the Football League, only 5 clubs have gone through a season without gaining a single away point. Div II Northwich Victoria 1893-4, Crew Alexandria 1894-5, Loughborough Town 1899-1900, Doncaster Rovers 1904-05 and Div III(N) Nelson 1930-31.
- 5. The first football match to be broadcast on the radio was a Division 1 match between Arsenal and Sheffield United at Highbury on 22 January 1927, and the first post-war FA Cup Final to be televised from start to finish was between Charlton Athletic and Burnley on 26 April 1947 Charlton won 1-0 after extra time watched by a crowd of 99,000.
- 6. One of the quickest "own goals" on record must go to Alan Mullery when playing for Fulham who scored for Sheffield Wednesday within 30 seconds of the start and before any Sheffield player had touched the ball. Mullery's embarrassing situation happened on 31 January 1961.

and finally under the heading of "Referees and Linesmen" comes the following unusual incident.

7. The famous occasion on which the referee was "sent off" by a tem captain occurred in the annual Sheffield v Glasgow Inter-City match on 22 September 1930 at Hampden Park. Sheffield were playing in white shirts and black shorts. The referee, Mr J Thomson of Burnbank, wore a white shirt without a jacket. Captaining Sheffield was inside-right, J Seed. As soon as he found that he was passing the ball to the referee in error, he asked Mr Thompson to stop the game and put a on a jacket - Mr Thompson obliged.




