



#### OUR VISITORS

Our visitors today, Viking Sports, who are members of The Middlesex FA, are making their first visit today to Wootton Bassett having joined Division 1 from the Premier Division at the beginning of the season.

This is our second encounter of the current campaign. On 30 September when Bassett made the trip to Greenford, they came away with an excellent 3-0 victory, with goals from Steve Ackrill, Warwick Burnett and Neil Timbrell at a time when Viking were previously unbeaten. But Viking bounced straight back from that home defeat and the following week visited Milton United who at the time were league leaders and won 2-1.

Viking made a good start to the season, winning six of their opening 7 fixtures but they lost their early momentum and stagnated on 18 points for some considerable time, only adding 4 more points by Christmas and yet again they rested on 22 points until 17 February when they beat Lambourn Sports 3-0.

They come to us today currently placed 9th in the league on 34 points, just one place behind Bassett, and of the 24 games played so far they have won 11 lost 12 and drawn only one, scoring a total of 25 goals and conceeding 34.

So today should hopefully, prove to be a good close encounter and of course Viking will obviously be looking to avenge the 3-0 home defeat back in September.


