Good afternoon, and a warm welcome to you all and to our visitors Highworth Town, in the first of our local derby's in the Premier Division.

I write this article whilst in positive mood, following our Bank Holiday victory away at Cheltenham Saracens. It is often the way that after 2 home games that we could, and probably should have won, we then go away for a tough fixture and gain all three points. As a club though we are realistic about the continued and consistent hard work we are all going to need to put in to take the club further forward this season, and the team displayed that determination and hard work Monday. Let's continue to play our part in the 'team' by giving the players our full and vocal support.

The most notable feature of the close seasons work is the erection of the floodlights, and I thought I would give you a little insight behind the work that went on. Following initial base construction work, we commissioned the SEC to purchase and install the floodlights. They had to wait until the end of the season, and then a wet June didn't help, but all was completed in good time, and hopefully you'll agree following our two evening games against Bath City and Milton United, they work extremely well. From the touchline there appear to be some dark patches, but reports from players and referees is that they are more than acceptable.

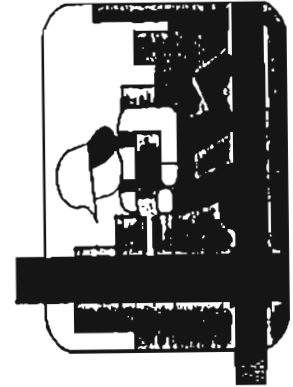

## Pen Portraits - Highworth Town

**Gary Goodwin (Manager)** Age 44 Since taking over in February 1997 when we were struggling at the bottom of the premier division, Gary has turned the club around by improving our league position in each of the following 3 full seasons, reaching 2nd last season. Add to this, the winning of the Wilts Senior Cup in 97-98 and the Supplementary Cup in 98-99 and, it is easy to see that a further improvement this season will be very difficult to achieve but everyone at the club believes it is possible. Gary is still registered as a player and can fill in, when required, as a central defender who can pass the ball accurately and hit a mean free kick. Previous clubs (as a player) : Garrards, Park YC, Fairford Town, Witney Town, Oxford City, Banbury Utd, Gloucester City, Forest Green Rovers, Abingdon Town, Cirencester Town and Lambourn. Honours : Winners medals in Wilts Youth Cup, Gloucester, Oxford and Wilts Senior Cups and has also played for a South West Counties and an FA XI. Previous Clubs as Manager/Coach include : Hungerford Town (player/mgr), Maidenhead Town, Didcot Town (player/mgr), Moreton Town (player/coach), Gloucester City (caretaker mgr), Cirencester Town (Assist. mgr) and Swindon Town (scout/coach). Honours: Hellenic Premier Championships with Abingdon Town, Moreton Town and Cirencester Town.

**Tommy Wheelton** Central defender. Age 21, who can more than play a bit! Currently developing as a fine attacking wing back. Good crosser with a superb shot. Previously with Swindon Town for 2 years and Weston-S-Mare.

The season has got off to an excellent start with some high scoring matches and high attendances. The first goal of the season was scored in the 1st minute between Aston Clinton & Finchampstead, Daniel Humphreys of Finchampstead netting the goal.

Quarry Nomads got off the mark scoring seven against Drayton Wanderers. Henley Town scored six without reply against Englefield Green Rovers.

In Division One West Bishops Cleeve beat Ardley United 4-2. Malmesbury Vics new to the league left it late to score in the 90th minute to secure a 1-0 win over Middle Barton. New boys Gloucester United and Witney Academy also recorded victories.

In the Premier Carterton notched up seven against Yate Town, while Fairford scored six without reply at home to Wootton Bassett Town. Almondsbury started well with a 3-0 win at Milton United.

Bank Holiday Monday saw 1609 spectators attend Premier Division matches. Six games attracted over 100 spectators each and 358 watched Didcot Town against Abingdon United while 352 attended Swindon Supermarine v Highworth Town.

Three Div One West games attracted over 100 with 190 watching Kidlington and Headington Amateurs. Purton and Malmesbury Vics attracted a crowd of 142.

One game in Div One East attracted a crowd of over 100 when 125 watched the game between Penn & Tyers Green and Chalfont Wasps.

In total 2,827 spectators attended Hellenic fixtures on Bank Holiday Monday.

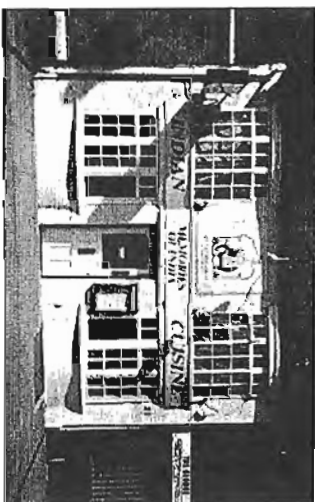

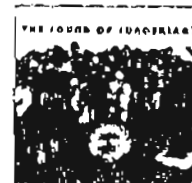
