Pegasus Juniors Football Club

Schoolteacher, Noel Watkins, who had been the manager of the successful Herefordshire County Schoolboys team, formed Pegasus Juniors in 1955. Rather than disband the team, the nucleus remained to form Pegasus Juniors Football Club.

The name was obtained following written permission from the original Pegasus Football Club, which was made up of both Oxford and Cambridge University players, on the condition that Juniors was included in the name.

After many seasons playing in the Herefordshire League and the Worcester League, Pegasus Juniors joined the Hellenic League in 1982. The Club ichieved its first league honours by winning Division One in 1985. This was repeated in 1999, after being relegated from the Premier Division due to ground regulations. The Club has won the H.F.A. County Cup on six occasions. Last season, after a difficult start, when the players adapted to the new challenges, they finished in a creditable tenth position.

The Club perhaps should have been called Pegasus Nomads as it has never been in a position to own or rent a ground which they could really call home, although they have had various home grounds including Nicholson Fields now accommodation for military personnel) and the Essex Arms. In between this the Club has used council pitches and for a while shared with Hereford United at Edgar Street, Hereford.

The Club has leased the Essex Arms Sports Ground for twenty five years but, with only twelve month leases have been unable upraise this to meet the equirements of the Premier Division. The reserve side now use this ground for Herefordshire Premier League fixtures.

This is almost certainly the last season this ground will be used by the club, is notice has been given that the lease will not be renewed at the conclusion of this season because the Police Authority intend to realise funds by selling the ground for development.

(CONTINUED (NET)

In 1978, it was decided the club needed a base and with players doing the majority of the work themselves 48 | 50 St. Owen Street, was converted from a vehicle repair garage into a social club.

In 1997, the Club signed a lease for a ground on the outskirts of Hereford; however, the Council refused planning permission. The Council applied to compulsory purchase the ground, the landowner appealed but this was dismissed. Ironically to date the Council have been unable to find sufficient funds to the buy the ground!

Last season Pegasus Juniors had three senior teams and an under 18 side playing in the West Midland Floodlight League. Links remain strong between the Club and Tupsley Pegasus whose youth teams operate at al levels from under 9's to under 16's and are a source of younger players.

The basis of this years team won the Division One tittle in 1998 | 1999 to enable a return to the Premier Division last year where they finished a creditable tenth. However this year the defence has been decimated with four players leaving for money offered by a local team playing in a lower league in the football pyramid.

A prolific goalscorer. "Davo" is in his third season with Pegasus, after being recruited from local football. In his first season he finished as leading goalscorer in the Hellenic League, last season he was runner up after being out for eight weeks with injury.

GRAY Matt

A product of the youth system gaining representative honours as county captain. Generally playing in defence however has shown potential in centre midfield.

HARRIS Leigh

An ex Hereford United apprentice, who possesses a great deal of ability.

HELME Lawrence

A product of the youth system gaining county representative honours. A left sided player presently studying at Cardiff University.

HOTCHKISS Neal

A right sided player who is often underrated, has pace and a good engine. Played in virtually every position except goalkeeper last season. A good clubman.

HOWARD Matt

A young goalkeeper with lots of potential a recent acquisition from Knighton Town in the Welsh League. Will soon be pushing for a first team place.

JAMES Andrew

An up and coming goalkeeper, a product of local football with a string of County youth appearances. In his third season with the Club.

JONES Darren

A forward player with plenty of skill, as a youth player had spells at Bromsgrove and Worcester.

MOON Danny

Signed at the start of last season from local rivals Westfields, a great midfield prospect who was a member of the county youth team last season. Playing at centre of defence this season.

POWELL Martin

Team captain and Mr Motivator who steadies and calms the side. Poweller has the knack of scoring important and usually match winning goals.

STONE Gavin

A front runner who is a product of the youth team. After a successful season with the reserves he is now fighting for first team a place.

SYMONDS Mike

A versatile local player from Leominster who has attained county representative honours.

THOMPSON Darren

A product of the club youth system a hard tackling midfield player with county representative honours.

WEST Adie

Signed at the beginning of the season for the youth team from local rivals Westfields. A great prospect who has already shown his ability to score goals.
