## Chairmans Chat

Good afternoon and welcome to you all and our visitors Cirencester Academy.

\*\*\*\*\*

Over the past few weeks the weather, unsurprisingly, has dominated my comments, so I didn't get the chance to share with you my thoughts on the appointment of Sven Goran Errikson to the England managers job. I ought to stress this article is written prior to the England game in Italy on Wednesday - let's hope the club 18-30 trippers played well.

Football has of course become more of a business and less of a sport over the past 20 years or so, and for me the appointment of Errikson simply reflects this fact. It is a business appointment of the person considered to be most appropriate to run the operational side of the business (in this instance a football team) irrespective of their nationality. To be successful though in a business you must have a feel for the company culture and adapt your management style to it. That for me is a crucial factor in the appointment of a national manager - irrespective of nationality they must understand the nature of the game in that country and the psychological make-up of the players. To be fair to Errikson he has been a student of English football, and referenced previously successful English managers. He has also been successful wherever he has been, but interestingly enough each of the club sides he has managed have finished lower in their first season under him than the previous manager. He needs time to change things, but with our media's desire for stories will he get it?

It is of course disappointing that we are currently unable to provide English candidates for the role, but it is never the less a fact that we are not blessed with the sort of production line the French FA have access to. Hopefully through the team management and coaching skills of Errikson, and the coaching development plans of the FA, this is a situation that will be corrected over the next few years.

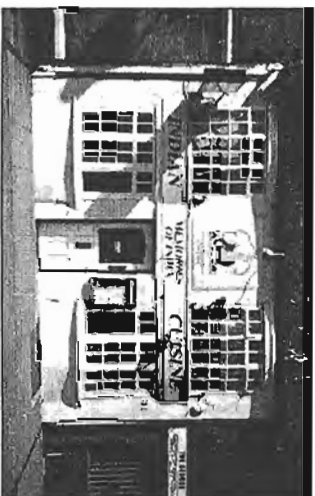
*This shows the team spirit in the club and due to Rich Stevens injury, Daryl Simms is with the first team today.*

### *Worthians Sign former International*

Manager Gary Goodwin may well have pulled off the signing of the season in the past couple of days with the registration of former Swindon Town player/manager Jimmy Quinn. A player with tremendous experience Jimmy has made over 700 appearances for a number of Nationwide League clubs including Blackburn Rovers, West Ham United and Peterborough United as well as spells as player/manager of Reading and Swindon Town, he has made over 50 international appearances for Northern Ireland as well. Since parting company with Swindon Town Quinn has had spells with Cirencester Town and latterly with Northwich Victoria and Hereford United in the 'Nationwide Conference'. He is expected to make his Highworth Town debut later this month, possibly in the Complete Music Challenge Cup at North Leigh on the 25<sup>th</sup> or against local rivals Swindon Supermarine if the Wiltshire Shield match is re-arranged before the 25<sup>th</sup>.

### *Keepers on the Move*

Abingdon United recently lost goalkeeper Carl Wilkins to Brackley Town following a seven day approach, a second seven day approach to 'United' by Banbury United for former No 1 keeper Simon Tricker seemed to be rejected by the player, until he had second thoughts and joined last seasons Hellenic League champions. Abingdon United General Manager John Blackmore was less than pleased at Tricker's U-turn and lack of loyalty to his club. Abingdon moved in for out of favour Jake Egby from Carterton Town and a transfer form is awaited. That leaves stand-by keeper Geoff Morton, who hasn't played a 1<sup>st</sup> team game this season, in goal for the FA Vase tie against Sussex League side Burgess Hill. Carterton Town made an approach for Bicester Town's goalkeeper Richard Darvill, this was rejected, and Carterton travel to Cornish side St Blazey, who top the Jewson South Western League with an unbeaten record this season, with Nick Heritage, a recent signing from Eynsham in goal for them.

### *Leading Goalscorers*

Danny Humphreys of Finchampstead is still the overall leading scorer with thirteen goals, (up to 31<sup>st</sup> October), Ben Milner of Brackley Town leads the Premier Division with 11 goals, Andy Keveran who has netted eleven times for Harrow Hill is trying his luck in the 'Doc Martens League' with Witney Town. Three of Gloucester United's players have scored 28 goals between them with only Steve Tucker of Ardley United getting in on the Div One (West) scene. Chasing Danny Humphreys in Div One (East) are Dale Bristow of RS Basingstoke and Ian Jones with eleven goals each.

Amesbury is a small town in Wiltshire approximately nine miles north of Salisbury, very close to the A303 and Stonehenge.

Amesbury Town FC was formed in 1904 and first played its football in a field near the historic monument of Stonehenge, although legend purporting they didn't need to bring along their own goalposts are unfounded!!

Amesbury Town played local football in the Salisbury League until progressing to County football after WW2.

It was not until the late 1950s/60s however that they started to gain County honours winning the Wiltshire League Division 1 title and the Wiltshire Subsidiary Cup in 1959/60.

However it was some 16 seasons later that further success came to the Town winning the Wilts Combination League in 1975/6 and, two seasons later, lifting the Wilts County League title for the first time. Town won the Wilts Senior Cup for the first time in 1984.

In the late '80s and early 90s the Club enjoyed its most successful period, winning the Wilts County title twice and finishing runners-up on three occasions as well as lifting the Wilts Senior Cup in 1993/4 for the second time.

It was now thought time for the Town to move forward, applied to join the Western League and duly took their place in the first division for the 1994/95 season. That first season was fairly successful with average gates of 99 and one crowd of over 200, finishing in 14<sup>th</sup> place out of 21.

However, the loss of key players over the next two seasons made them struggle and the Club finished bottom in season 1996/97. Although Town could have continued in the Western League, the Club took the decision to withdraw, mainly due to the problem of finding players willing to travel the long distances involved to fulfil fixtures and costs incurred in travelling those long distances.

It was decided to re-group and run just one senior side in the Salisbury and District League for the 1997/98 season. Previously, a Reserve side operated in the Wilts County League.

In the meantime, the Club was looking to progress in a different direction and applied to join the Hampshire League. With Amesbury being close to the A303 and only a few miles from the Hampshire border this was indeed the best option for the Club.

Following their election to the Hampshire League Amesbury Town FC have made steady progress culminating in them winning the Premier Division Championship last season.

The Town's commitment to youth over the years has paid dividends as they continue to run an U18 side in the Wilts County FA Youth Floodlight League and ended last season as League Champions.
