

Good evening and welcome to you all, and our visitors Tuffley Rovers.



#### Floodlit Cup Final



#### TUFFLEY ROVERS F. C.

#### A BRIEF HISTORY

The late Donald E Hall, who for many years was both its Secretary and Treasurer, founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League but since 1932, apart from the war years and two other short periods has always maintained a team (now the 3rd XI) in the Stroud League.

Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League. After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991 and their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and were accepted into Division One for the following season.

Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion have been competing in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League since 1993/1994 regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final.

Whilst the Club has enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI have also gained promotion and championship honours to reach their present positions in the pyramid system and are currently well established in Division One of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League (2nd XI) and Division Two of the Stroud League (3rd XI). The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion however, was not possible as reserve teams are not allowed to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

Over the past season or two a number of senior players have retired or left for pastures new, but the management team of Chris Gardner and Geoff Samuels have assembled a squad with a lot of younger players and are currently passing on their experience to them.
