



Heres to a good game this afternoon - Cheers, "H"





# North Leigh Football Club

North Leigh were formed in 1908, but it was only following the Second World War that they started to make their mark in the Witney and District League.

They won the Witney and District League Premier Division title seven times in the 1950s and also enjoyed success in the Oxfordshire Senior Cup. In the 1980s they resumed their trophy winning habits with five successive Witney and District League titles earning them a place in the Hellenic League Division 1 for the season 1990/91.

They enjoyed a good first season in the Hellenic League, finishing in 4th position and being the Division's highest goal scorers apart from Champions Cinderford Town. In their second season they again achieved 4th position, averaging two points per game. scoring 84 goals in the process.

In their third season, they finished runners up to Tuffley Rovers in Division 1 and so took their place in the Hellenic League Premier Division along with the Champions.

Their first FA Challenge Vase campaign in the 1992/93 season saw them progress to the second round by defeating Flight Refuelling, Fairford Town and Bristol Manor Farm, before losing 3-0 to Cranleigh, 1993/94 also saw them progress to the second round as they defeated Wessex League opponents Swanage Town and Christchurch before losing 2-1 at Thame United.

In 1997/98 they reached the second round of the FA Vase for the third time before losing to Elmore. They finished the season in 4th place in the Hellenic League Premier Division, and capped their season off by reaching the final of the Oxfordshire Senior Cup where they were only narrowly beaten by their West Oxfordshire rivals Witney Town 1-0 after extra time.

During North Leigh's history, they have also won the Oxfordshire Junior Shield, the Oxfordshire Charity Cup and the Oxfordshire Youth Cup twice.

Improved facilities at their Eynsham Park ground include floodlights, a stand incorporating approximately 150 seats, and for the start of season 1998/99, a £100,000 changing room block including a committee room, kitchen and public toilets.

This will hopefully help this progressive West Oxfordshire club to consolidate their status in senior football.

I am pleased to say that they have continued their unbeaten run for the season and have a semi-final to look forward too.






