### **HENLEY TOWN PREPARE FORTHE PREMIER DIVISION**

Ground improvements to bring Henley Town's Triangle ground in Mill Lane up to Hellenic League Premier Division standard are well underway. The base for a 60-seater stand, with facilities for the disabled, has been laid and the main stand structure will be up before the end of June. Cabling for three-phase electricity has been brought to the ground from the other side of the railway line and floodlighting will be installed as soon as the season ends. Standing cover for at least 50 people will be put up and six foot fencing will enclose the ground. New pitch barriers are to be put up and a pitch irrigation system installed. The dressing rooms will be brought up to Southern League standard and alterations are also taking place to improve the bar area and clubroom. Most of the funding for the improvements has come from the Football Foundation, Henley Town Council and the South Oxfordshire District Council and the remainder from club functions. The Hellenic League side has applied to enter the FA Vase and the Youth team to join the Allied Counties Youth League for the 2001-2002 season.

#### **John Fathers**

It is with regret that the Oxfordshire Football Association announces the passing of John Fathers, Representative to the Football Association for Oxfordshire since 1998. John passed away at 10.10 a.m. on Friday 20 April 2001 after a short battle with cancer. John had been on the Council of the Oxfordshire Football Association since 1986 when he became Referees Appointments Secretary. In 2000 John became a Director of the Association. John leaves his wife, Hazel, and two daughters, Jane and Linda. He will be sadly missed. Rest in peace. It would be appropriate for Oxfordshire affiliated clubs, whether at home or away, to observe a minute's silence prior to Hellenic League matches being played on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> April. Should clubs from other County Associations wish to observe a minute's silence prior to their fixtures it would be much appreciated?

#### **Floodlit Cup Final**

Thursday evening eventually saw the final match in this season's 'Norman Matthews' Floodlit Cup competition. On a bitterly cold April evening three intrapud League Officers, the Chairman, Referee Appointment's Secretary and the General Secretary visited the very much improved Swindon Supermarine ground for the final between the champions elect of the Premier Division in Swindon Supermarine and league new boys and champions elect of Division One (West) Gloucester United. The pitch was in reasonable condition although a little

bumpy in some areas considering the rainfall of recent months and the number of postponements due to the waterlogged state of the pitch. There were very few goal scoring chances for either team due to the defensive qualities of the competing clubs, especially the respective center backs, Pete Farrow and Mick Casey of 'Marine' and Andy Pritchett and Neil Long of 'United'. Most of the play was in the center third of the pitch with both sets of midfield players working hard. The only goal of the game came in the 7<sup>th</sup> minute of added time in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half when Gloucester goalkeeper Craig Barnfield, who had not made a mistake during the game, misjudged the collection of the ball and dropped it at the feet of Steve Davies who knocked the ball home from three yards. Supermarine retain the Floodlit Cup they won by beating Banbury United over two legs last season and look forward to attempting another cup double as well as looking forward to the Premier Division championship.

#### **Another Referee 'Plum'**

Further news on referee 'plum' appointments, I heard today that Hellenic League referee Nigel Wyatt of Thatcham has been appointed as match referee for the England Schools Under 18's v Wales Schools Under 18's on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May. The fixture is due to be played at Swindon Town FC (with a 7pm kick off).
